What is Sikhism? — Sikhism is based on the concept of universal acceptance of all humanity and the belief in One Creator. Sikhism **originated over 500 years ago in northwestern India** with a simple message of truthful living. The universal nature of the Sikh path reaches out to people of all faiths and cultural backgrounds, encouraging us to see beyond our differences and to work together for world peace and harmony. The Sikh identity also symbolizes solidarity and respect for the teachings of our ten prophets (Gurus), stressing common humanity, respect, equality, and compassion for all. **A Sikh is NOT a Muslim or a Hindu.**

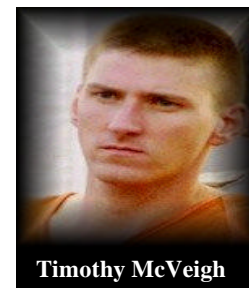
